70 out of 145 qualified PPI projects have already been concluded. Other 75 projects are expected to be completed by 2018 with estimated investments exceeding US\$ 40 billion. More than 50 out of the remaining projects are focused on expanding investments in logistics in order to modernize the country's infrastructure and create thousands of jobs. In January



2nd and 3rd Pre-Salt Rounds

The contracts with the companies that won the bid were signed on January 31st. An amount of US\$ 30.3 billion will be invested and the grants total US\$ 1.863 billion.



4th Production Sharing Round

The pre-public bid notice and contract draft were published with a signing bonus minimum grant of US\$ 440 million.



North-South Railway

National Agency of Land Transportation (ANTT) approved the public hearing report and now studies will be adjusted to incorporate the contributions. The next step will be TCU's evaluation.



Port leases

Federal Auditing Court (TCU) approved, on January 24th, the lease of the following terminals: PAR 01, PAR 12, IQI 18 and MCP1. The selection criterion will be the highest grant value and the contract will last 25 years.

15th Round of Exploratory Blocks

The public notice and contract model for the project were published. Blocks will be offered in land and sedimentary basins and the minimum grant will be R\$ 5.7 billion (US\$ 1.7 billion). The public auction will be held on March 29th.
